# **ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER S-2012-003** (Supersedes Administrative Order S-2008-166)

### **TOBACCO LITIGATION**

It is necessary for the proper and efficient administration of justice in the General Civil Division to amend the procedures for the management of tobacco personal injury litigation. By the power vested in the chief judge under article V, section 2(D), Florida Constitution; section 43.26, Florida Statutes; and Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215(b)(2), it is therefore **ORDERED:** 

#### 1. General Civil Division "C" - Pretrial Matters

All tobacco personal injury lawsuits which are pending in General Civil Division "D," except cases which have already been activated for trial, will be transferred to General Civil Division "C" to be coordinated for pretrial proceedings.

#### 2. Trial

When counsel have identified cases ready for trial according to the respective case management orders, the presiding judge of General Civil Division "C" will direct the Clerk of the Circuit Court to assign such cases to divisions in the General Civil Division, excluding Divisions "L," "T" and "Z," using a random and equitable distribution system. Any cases transferred from Division "C" to another division for trial will remain assigned to the successor division for all matters.

#### 3. Previous Administrative Order Superseded

This administrative order supersedes Administrative Order S-2008-166 (*Tobacco Litigation*).

#### 4. Effective Date

This administrative order is effective immediately.
