**JUDICIAL ASSIGNMENT -  
COUNTY JUDGE J. LOGAN MURPHY**

Florida Governor Ron DeSantis recently appointed the Honorable J. Logan Murphy as a judge of the Hillsborough County Court. In light of this recent judicial appointment, it is necessary to assign Judge Murphy to a specific subject matter subdivision. Florida Rule of General Practice and Judicial Administration 2.215(b)(4) empowers the chief judge to assign judges to the courts and divisions and to determine the length of each assignment. Rule 2.215(b)(2) provides that the chief judge may enter and sign administrative orders.

By the power vested in the chief judge under article V, section 2(d), Florida Constitution; section 43.26, Florida Statutes; and the above-referenced judicial administration rules, it is ORDERED:

Senior judges are temporarily assigned to County Civil Division "J" through July 9, 2021. Effective July 12, 2021, *J. Logan Murphy* is assigned to County Civil Division "J."
