**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER A-2025-004
(Amends Administrative Order A-2024-075)**

**JUDICIAL ASSIGNMENTS – APPOINTMENT OF CIRCUIT JUDGE
ANNE-LEIGH GAYLORD MOE TO THE SECOND DISTRICT COURT
OF APPEAL**

The Honorable Anne-Leigh Gaylord Moe was appointed to the Second District Court of Appeal by Florida Governor Ron DeSantis. As a result, it is necessary to make certain judicial reassignments. Rule of General Practice and Judicial Administration 2.215(b)(4) empowers the chief judge to assign judges to the courts and divisions and to determine the length of each assignment. Rule 2.215(b)(2) provides that the chief judge may enter and sign administrative orders.

By the power vested in the chief judge under article V, section 2(d), Florida Constitution; section 43.26, Florida Statutes; and the above-referenced judicial administration rules, it is ORDERED:

Circuit Civil Division

Cynthia S. Oster is assigned to Circuit Civil Division “E” effective January 27, 2025.

Family Law Division

Cynthia S. Oster is assigned to Family Law Division “A” through January 26, 2025. Effective January 27, 2025, *Matthew L. Felix* is temporarily appointed as an acting circuit court judge and assigned to Family Law Division “A.”

COUNTY COURT


County Civil Division

Matthew L. Felix is assigned to County Civil Division “N” through January 26, 2025. Effective January 27, 2025, senior judges are temporarily assigned to County Civil Division “N.”
