ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER S-2021-037

**ESTABLISHMENT OF COUNTY CIVIL
DIVISIONS “N,” “O,” and “P”**

Section 2 of Chapter 2021-45, Laws of Florida, amends section 34.022(28), Florida Statutes, effective July 1, 2021, increasing the number of Hillsborough County Court judges. In light of this development, it is necessary for the proper administration of justice within this circuit to establish additional subdivisions in the County Civil Division to assist with the increased caseload.

By the power vested in the chief judge under article V, section 2(d), Florida Constitution; section 43.26, Florida Statutes; and Florida Rule of General Practice and Judicial Administration 2.215(b)(2), it is ORDERED:

1. County Civil Division “N”

Division “N” is established as a new subdivision in the County Civil Division.

2. County Civil Division “O”

Division “O” is established as a new subdivision in the County Civil Division.

3. County Civil Division “P”

Division “P” is established as a new subdivision in the County Civil Division.

4. Administrative Provisions


Case allocation provisions in response to the establishment of Divisions “N,” “O,” and “P” will be promulgated by a subsequent administrative order dealing with the County Civil Division.

5. Effective Date

County Civil Divisions “N,” “O,” and “P” are established immediately for preparation and setup purposes. The first day of operation for these new subdivisions of the County Civil Division will

be coordinated with the Administrative Office of the Courts and the Clerk of the Court.
