ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER S-2021-038

**ESTABLISHMENT OF COUNTY CIVIL
TRAFFIC DIVISION "R"**

Section 2 of Chapter 2021-45, Laws of Florida, amends section 34.022(28), Florida Statutes, effective July 1, 2021, increasing the number of Hillsborough County Court judges. In light of this development, it is necessary for the proper administration of justice within this circuit to establish an additional subdivision to assist in the disposition of civil traffic infraction cases.

By the power vested in the chief judge under article V, section 2(d), Florida Constitution; section 43.26, Florida Statutes; and Florida Rule of General Practice and Judicial Administration 2.215(b)(2), it is ORDERED:

1. County Civil Traffic Division "R"

County Civil Traffic Division "R" is established as a new subdivision to handle civil traffic offenses.


2. Administrative Provisions

Case allocation provisions in response to the establishment of County Civil Traffic Division "R" will be promulgated by a subsequent administrative order dealing with the County Civil Traffic Division.

3. Effective Date

County Civil Traffic Division "R" is established immediately for preparation and setup purposes. The first day of operation for this new civil traffic subdivision will be coordinated with the Administrative Office of the Courts and the Clerk of the Court.
