RESCISSION OF ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER S-2020-021 (RELEASE OF CERTAIN PRETRIAL DETAINEES TO MITIGATE THREAT OF COVID-19)

Administrative Order S-2020-021 (Release of Certain Pretrial Detainees to Mitigate Threat of COVID-19) was entered in response to the public health emergency that existed in the State of Florida because of the spread of COVID-19. In light of the expiration of both the federal public health emergency and the state of emergency declared for the State of Florida in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, Administrative Order S-2020-021 (Release of Certain Pretrial Detainees to Mitigate Threat of COVID-19) has served its purpose and is no longer necessary.

By the power vested in the chief judge under article V, section 2(d), Florida Constitution; section 43.26, Florida Statutes, and Florida Rule of General Practice and Judicial Administration 2.215(b)(2), it is ORDERED:

Administrative Order S-2020-021 (*Release of Certain Pretrial Detainees to Mitigate Threat of COVID-19*) is rescinded effective immediately.
