ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER S-2024-008

**RE-DESIGNATING COUNTY CIVIL TRAFFIC DIVISION "F"
AS COUNTY CIVIL TRAFFIC DIVISION "M"**

There currently exists in the County Court two Division "F"s: County Criminal Division "F" and County Civil Traffic Division "F." On March 1, 2024, in addition to domestic violence cases, County Criminal Division "F" will begin hearing county criminal cases involving defendants with last names beginning with certain letters, including criminal traffic cases. In order to avoid potential confusion in the Traffic Bureau, it is necessary to change the designation of the traffic division from County Civil Traffic Division "F" to County Civil Traffic Division "M."

By the power vested in the chief judge under article V, section 2(d), Florida Constitution; section 43.26, Florida Statutes; and Florida Rule of General Practice and Judicial Administration 2.215(b)(2), it is ORDERED:

1. Changing Designation of Traffic Division

County Civil Traffic Division "F" is hereby re-designated as County Civil Traffic Division "M."

2. Effective Date

This administrative order is effective March 1, 2024.
