ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER S-2026-022

ABOLITION OF JUVENILE DEPENDENCY DIVISION "C"

It is necessary for the efficient and effective usage of judicial resources in this circuit to abolish Juvenile Dependency Division "C." By the power vested in the chief judge under article V, section 2(d), Florida Constitution; Florida Statutes section 43.26; and Florida Rule of General Practice and Judicial Administration 2.215(b)(2), it is ORDERED:

1. Juvenile Dependency Division "C"

Juvenile Dependency Division "C" is hereby abolished.


2. Administrative Procedures
