Each year, Hillsborough County Sheriff's employees who work at the courthouse organize a toy drive for children who meet with their parents at the Children's Justice Center as part of court-ordered visitation. Judges order these visits in criminal, domestic violence, family law and dependency cases. Some of the kids live in foster homes; others are at the center of a custody dispute. Deputies and other court employees wrapped presents for 107 children from 65 homes, which will be given out next week during scheduled visits.
