ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI

The petition is DENIED. *Vodar v. Dep't of Highway Safety & Motor Vehicles*, 15 Fla. L. Weekly Supp. 226a (Fla. 13th Cir. Ct. 2008) (finding that the Department is not required to conduct a hearing within 30 days and may reschedule the hearing after the initially scheduled date); *Dep't of Highway Safety & Motor Vehicles v. Rose*, 105 So. 3d 22, 24 (Fla. 2d DCA 2012) (stating that the circuit court is not permitted to reweigh evidence or substitute its judgment for that of the hearing officer and that the absence of the odor of alcohol is not sufficient grounds to quash a license suspension where other signs of impairment were observed).
