**ORDER DIRECTING SUPERVISED VISITATION AT THE
CHILDREN’S JUSTICE CENTER AND REFERRAL TO THE
BEHAVIORAL HEALTH PROGRAMS**

THIS CAUSE came before the Court on _____. The Court, having reviewed the file and heard testimony, finds that supervised visitation at the Children’s Justice Center (“CJC”) between the parent and the child(ren) listed below is in the best interest of the child(ren):

In addition to the supervised visitation at the CJC, the Court also finds that it is appropriate for both the Petitioner and Respondent to engage in the services of the Behavioral Health Programs (“BHP”).

IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

1. _____ shall be entitled to supervised visitation with the above-named children at the Children’s Justice Center.

2. Both the Petitioner and Respondent are hereby referred to the services of the Behavioral Health Programs (“BHP”).
3. The Petitioner and Respondent are required to comply with the policies and procedures adopted by the Behavioral Health Programs and Children’s Justice Center, which shall govern the manner in which services and visitations are conducted.
4. Within three (3) business days of the entry of this Order, the Petitioner and Respondent must contact both the Behavioral Health Programs and the Children’s Justice Center to initiate visitation and services, pursuant to the following instructions:
 - a. Both parties shall contact the **Behavioral Health Programs (“BHP”)** at **813-307-4478** to initiate screening, needs assessment, and a case management plan.
 - b. Both parties shall contact the **Children’s Justice Center (“CJC”)** at **813-272-7179** to initiate supervised visitation services.
2. If either or both of the parties fail to contact the BHP or CJC within the required timeframe, CJC’s Initial Outcome Report shall update the Court on the details of the noncompliance.¹
3. Upon contact from the parties, the BHP and CJC will ensure that supervised visitation and services are scheduled within ten (10) days.
4. Supervised visitation at the CJC shall be subject to the availability and discretion of the CJC, in addition to the following:
 - a. All visitations provided for herein shall take place at the Children’s Justice Center: 700 E. Twiggs Street, #102, Tampa, FL 33602.
 - b. Prior to the initial visitation, each party must pay a standard, one-time fee for the CJC’s services. Additional information will be provided by the CJC.
 - c. The visitation will occur one time each week for one hour, with the visiting party arriving 15 minutes before the visitation and remaining 15 minutes after the visitation.

¹ The Children’s Justice Center (“CJC”) will provide an update to the Court in its Initial Outcome Report within fourteen (14) days of receipt of this Order.

- d. Persons, other than the Petitioner and Respondent, who may participate in the supervised visitation are: _____. No other persons shall participate in the supervised visitations.
8. This case should be scheduled for a Judicial Status Review within _____ at which point the Court will review the Court Supervised Visitation Overview provided by the CJC, the Outcome Report provided by the BHP, and may terminate the supervised visitation or modify timesharing.²
9. In the event that the case progresses to a resolution or an emergent issues arises requiring judicial resolution, the BHP may file additional status reports to address the Court, as needed.
