Notes to Parties:

1. Prepare a joint exhibit notebook.
2. Each exhibit should be separated by a numbered tab. Please make sure that the numbered tabs match the exhibit notebook.
3. Bring a minimum of four (4) identical copies of the exhibit notebook. One copy is for Petitioner, one for Respondent, one for the Court, one for the witness stand.

4. Please arrive at least fifteen (15) minutes early for the final hearing and pre-mark each exhibit in the notebooks given to the witness and the Court. Pre-marking stamps are in the white basket on the court reporter's desk.
5. The exhibit notebook on the witness stand will contain the record exhibits.
6. If the answer to "Agreed" is "Yes" then the exhibit will be moved into evidence at the outset of the final hearing.
7. If the answer to "Agreed" is "No" then all evidentiary objections must be listed in the next column. Those objections will be ruled upon at the time the exhibit is offered into evidence.
8. Evidentiary objections not disclosed on the exhibit list are waived.
